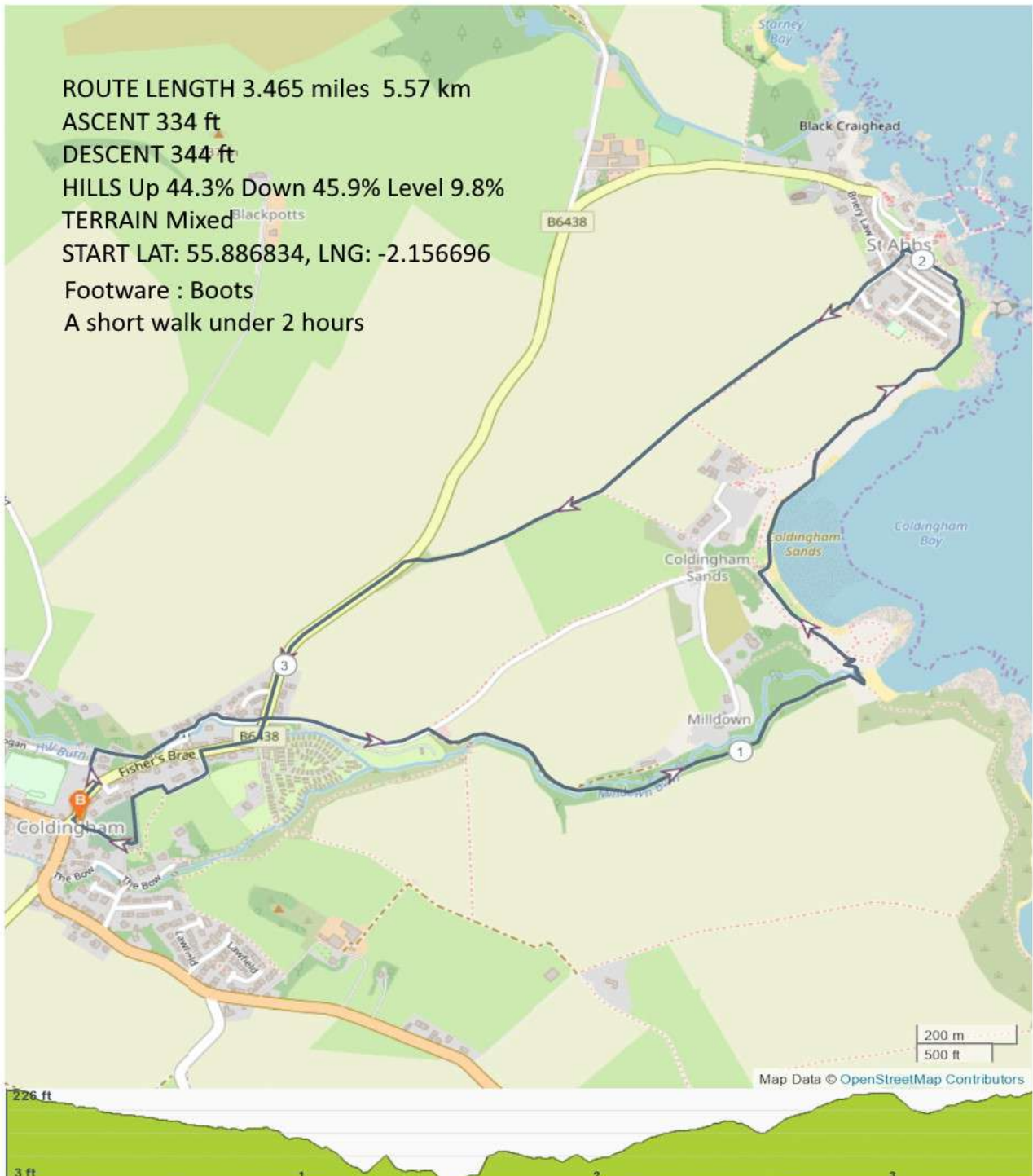


Coldingham - Milldown - Creel Path



Coldingham - Milldown Bay - St Abbs - Creel Path - Coldingham

Pleasant quiet walk with fantastic views of the countryside.

Start and finish: Village Hall Car Park

Terrain: minor roads and cross country, **Boots Recommended.**

Toilets: Coldingham Village Car Park, key in cafe. Check opening hours.

The walk takes just under **2 hours** taking in the views.



The footpath running below Fishers Brae. Turn left just past the Spar shop taking you past the Bogan



A small unfenced section – take care as there is a drop on the left.



The Path to Milldown Bay. The entrance is just after you walk past Scoutscroft Holiday Park on the road that leads Coldingham Bay



Cross the burn using the stepping stones to take to Milldown Bay. If you decide not to then stay on the path which leads to Coldingham Bay



Having crossed the burn continue on the path that leads to Milldown Bay.



The end of the path having reached Milldown Bay.



Cross the bridge and take the steps up to Homeli Knoll and continue on to Coldingham Bay.

Use the steps at the end on Coldingham Bay to take you to the Coastal Path and onto St Abbs.

The Creel Path. The St Abbs entrance as this walk is anti-clockwise. Heading back to Coldingham.

Entrance to Chariots Road. This will return you to the Village Hall Car Park via the Priory.
