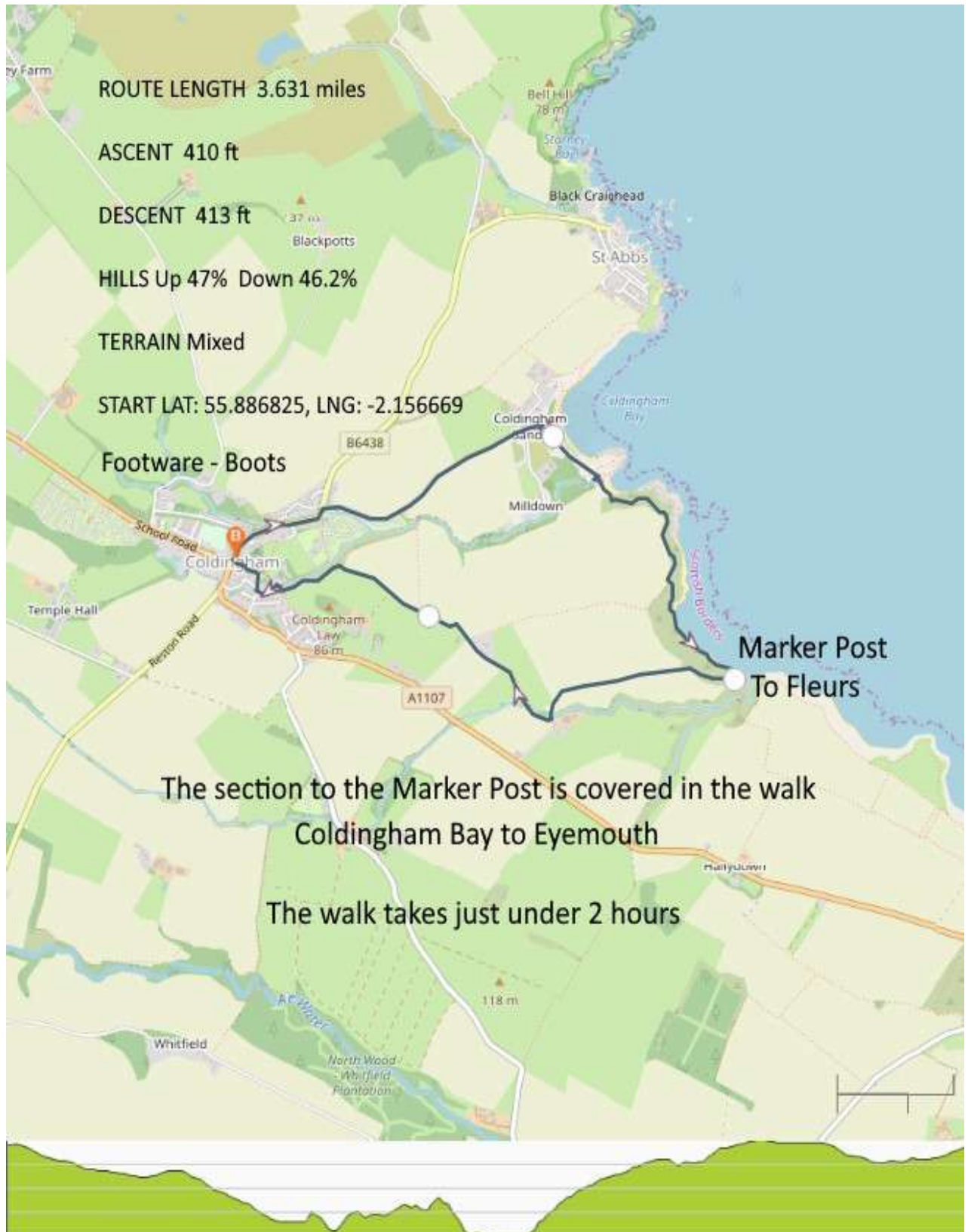


Linkim (Circular Walk)



Linkim Bay Circular via Fleurs

Pleasant quiet walk with fantastic views of the countryside.

Start and finish: Village Car Park

Terrain: minor roads and cross country, **Boots Recommended.**

Toilets: Coldingham Village Car Park, key in cafe. Check opening hours.

The walk takes just under **2 hours** taking in the views.



No Ferns (February) – Uphill to Fleurs. Marker post at the end of Linkim Bay.

The style marked Ebba with direction arrow towards Fleurs.



Looking back over the sea. The marked path to use is on the left of the fence. Not from where the image was taken.



Fleurs can be seen on the left. Head towards Fleurs, down a dip and take a right turn towards the copse. The walk takes you through the copse.



Walked in July where there was significant undergrowth.



Yes, there is style there as well as a post marking the route.



Reaching the end of the copse the route widens significantly.



Continue on and follow the track just past the house on the right, Slightly downhill.



The track then turns into a single track path. Still going slightly downhill.



Taking the path to the Bow. You will see another exit over a small bridge that leads to Scoutscroft.
